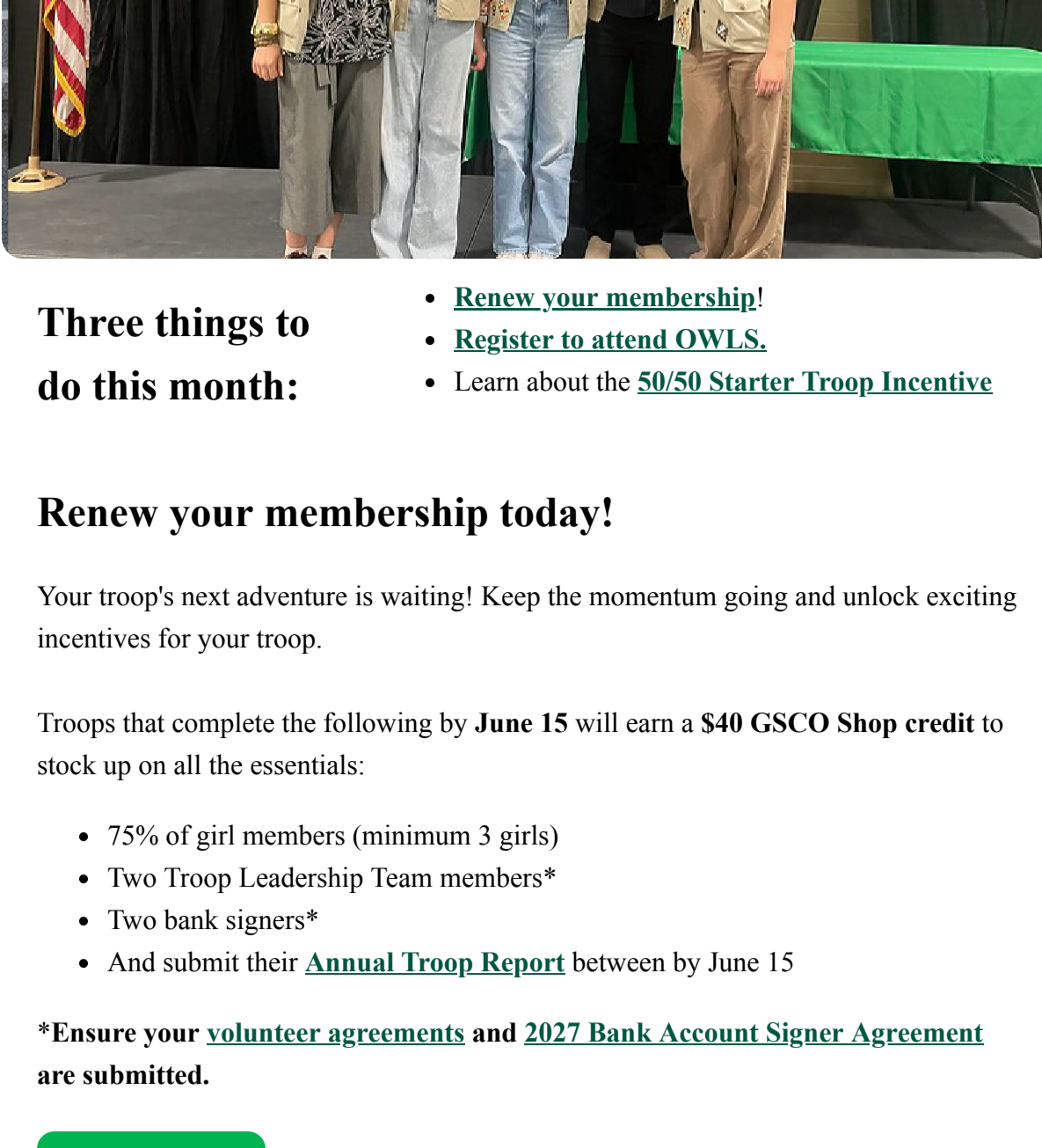

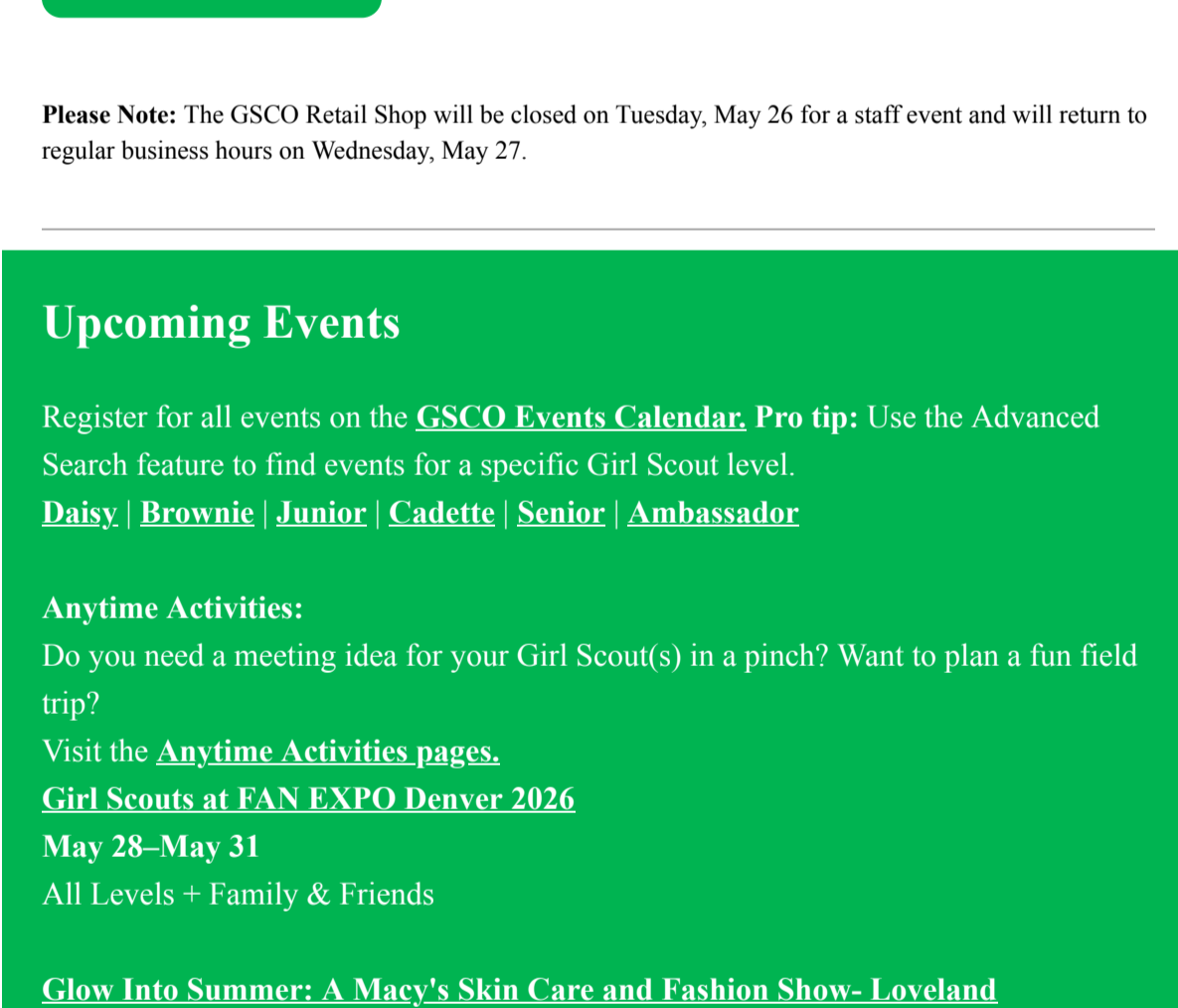
2026-2027 Volunteer Agreements and ACH form
Thank you for supporting Girl Scout success through our product programs! Troop volunteers who raise their hands to be Fall Product Program Manager (TFPM) or Cookie Program Manager (TCM), as well as caregivers of Girl Scout Juliettes who act as TFPMs and/or TCMs for their Girl Scout(s), all play a vital part in making these programs fun and successful for your Girl Scouts.

To stay active in the product program volunteer roles, a few forms need to be completed each year.

TFPM or TCM agreement form criteria to be approved:

- You must have a current GSCO membership for the 2026-2027 Girl Scout year, as well as a current and approved background check.
- If you're a new Girl Scouts of Colorado volunteer, you will also need to complete a [GSCO volunteer agreement form](#).
- Your troop must have a current ACH form on file with council.
- If your troop submitted an ACH form for 2024-2025 or for 2025-2026 and it was approved, *and there are no changes to your troop bank account or to the signers on the account*, then you DO NOT need to submit an ACH form for 2025-2026.
- Juliette caregivers acting as TFPMs or TCMs for their Girl Scout(s) *do not* need to complete an ACH form.
- If your troop is new or if there are changes to your bank account or new or different bank account signers, your troop needs to complete a [2026-2027 ACH form](#).
