Youth Mental Health First Aid (YMHFA) is an early intervention public education program provided by the National Council for Mental Health that teaches adults how to recognize and respond to signs of mental health challenges in youth. Participants learn how to identify warning signs and symptoms, listen without judgement, offer reassurance and support, and connect youth to professional help and resources when needed.

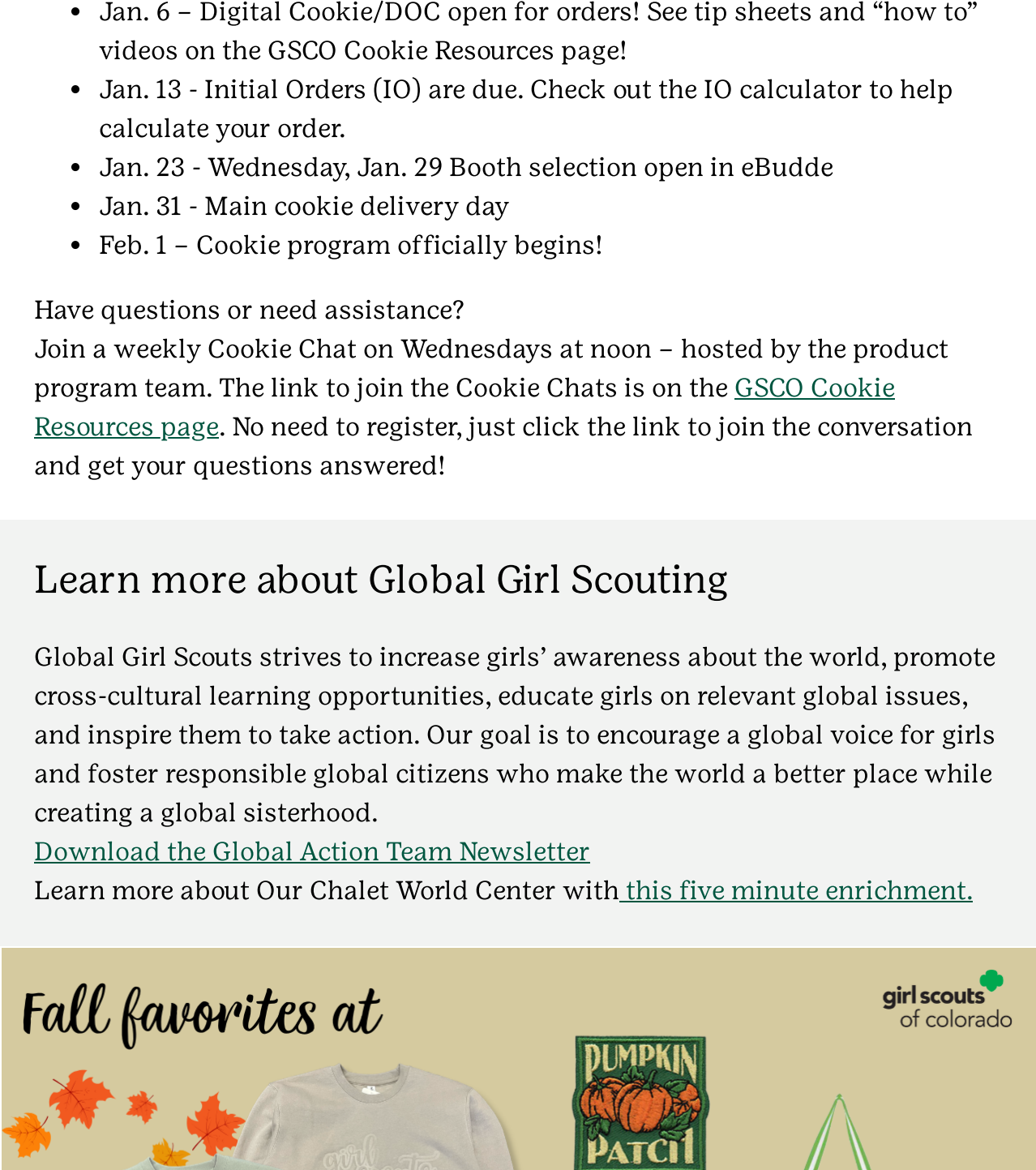
## Supporting our community

As Girl Scouts we are always looking for ways to change the world, especially by making an impact in our local communities. If your troop is planning on hosting food drives, please remember that members of your troop may also be facing food insecurity, so it is important to handle these conversations with care. Additionally, troops should visit the website of the organization where they hope to donate, as the organization will highlight the most critical donation needs that they have.

GSCO is dedicated to removing as many barriers as possible for families so their child may experience all that Girl Scouts has to offer. We know cost of programs can be a barrier, whether it be brought on by an unforeseen emergency or the state of the current economy. [To help ensure every girl has access, GSCO offers grants and scholarships to lower, and in some cases, remove this barrier.](#)
